CHRONIC TOXICITY: Gallium and gallium compounds may cause metallic taste, dermatitis, and depression of the bone marrow function. Large doses may cause hemorrhagic nephritis. Tellurium is converted in the body to dimethyl telluride which imparts a garlic like odor to the breath and sweat. Heavy exposure may result in headache, drowsiness, metallic taste, loss of appetite, nausea,

tremors, convulsions, and respiratory tract.
